THE WATERSIDE DUCK BOX

SETTING UP

There are three parts to your Waterside Duck Box: the box itself, the ladder and the post.

Set the post up in a vertical position, knocking it into the ground (sharp end down) with a mallet or similar. Please take care to hit the top of the post squarely so as not to split the post. Ensure the post is firmly held in the ground. Other methods of fixing the post (such as setting in concrete, or using a bracket) can be equally effective, depending on the site you have chosen.

The bottom of the box is attached to the top of the post by resting the box on the top of the 'shoe' part way down the post, with the back to the post, and whilst it located there, securing the top and bottom of the back of the box to the post with short woodscrews.

To remove the box for cleaning purposes, etc. all you need do is to unscrew the screws and take the box off without disturbing the post. If you have a number of boxes, they will all be interchangeable with each other when it comes to replacing them.

The ladder is attached by hooking the two rungs on the underside at the top of the ladder into the entrance at the front of the box.
