# Mains to Battery Extension Cable

## Components

- 1 Cable
- 1 Polythene Tube
- 4 Cable Ties

This is a 2 core low voltage extension cable designed to extend the distance between the Mains Power Supply Unit and the Battery Connector or Battery Box.

## Fitting

1. Snap one end of this cable to the matching PP3 connector on the mains Power Supply Unit.
2. Snap the other end of the cable to the mating PP3 connector where you would have otherwise fitted the mains PSU, ie to the PP3 connector marked with yellow sleeving in the battery box. If possible, ensure that the joint formed by these connectors is kept inside the box or otherwise in the dry.
3. If you wish to fit one of the cable joints outside, disconnect the connectors, fit the Polythene Tube over the cable and fit the connectors together again. Position the Tube so that it covers the joint and using 2 Cable Ties at each end, tighten it at each end over the two cables to make the joint weather-proof.
4. Plug in the PSU and check that the system works as it does when the PSU is connected directly to the Battery Box.
